
## THE ODYSSEY: PART 2



## **ACROSS**

- 4 A long narrative poem about the adventures of a hero
- 6 Telemachus assumes that Odysseus is one of these when Odysseus changes his physical appearance
- 7 The god/goddess who fights on Odysseus's side during the battle with the suitors
- 14 Odysseus's father
- 16 General term for the central heroic figure of an epic
- 17 Odysseus is king of this place
- 18 Odysseus uses this weapon to kill Antinous
- 19 They have overrun Odysseus's home and are trying to win over Penelope
- 20 Personality trait for which Odysseus is best known; this quality makes him a favorite of Athena
- 21 To avoid marriage, Penelope weaves this during the day, but undoes it during the night
- 23 After Antinous is killed, this suitor tries to persuade Odysseus to spare the lives of the rest of them

24 Penelope's test of Odysseus involves his knowledge of this item that the two of them share

- 1 Odysseus assumes this disguise when he returns home
- 2 The protagonist of The Odyssey
- 3 Odysseus's faithful wife
- 5 Latin expression meaning "in the middle of things"
- 8 An elaborate comparison between 2 unlike things; sometimes uses like or as, sometimes uses a colon with "just so"
- 9 The cruelest of Penelope's suitors
- 10 Type of poem that tells a story
- 11 A repeated description, such as "wise Odysseus" or "gray-eyed Athena"; used to meet a rhyme or rhythm requirement
- 12 Penelope's female servant who also dislikes the suitors
- 13 Odysseus's son
- 15 Odysseus's loyal swineherd
- 18 Odysseus's dog
- 22 He wrote The Odyssey
