- 1 He wrote The Odyssey
- 2 Type of poem that tells a story
- 3 A long narrative poem about the adventures of a hero
- 4 General term for the central heroic figure of an epic
- 5 An elaborate comparison between 2 unlike things; sometimes uses like or as, sometimes uses a colon with "just so"
- 6 The protagonist of The Odyssey
- 7 Personality trait for which Odysseus is best known; this quality makes him a favorite of Athena
- 8 A repeated description, such as "wise Odysseus" or "gray-eyed Athena"; used to meet a rhyme or rhythm requirement
- 9 Latin expression meaning "in the middle of things"
- 10 They have overrun Odysseus's home and are trying to win over Penelope
- 11 Odysseus's faithful wife
- 12 Odysseus's father
- 13 Odysseus assumes this disguise when he returns home
- 14 Odysseus is king of this place
- 15 Odysseus's son
- 16 Telemachus assumes that Odysseus is one of these when Odysseus changes his physical appearance
- 17 Odysseus's dog
- 18 The cruelest of Penelope's suitors
- 19 To avoid marriage, Penelope weaves this during the day, but undoes it during the night
- 20 After Antinous is killed, this suitor tries to persuade Odysseus to spare the lives of the rest of them
- 21 The god/goddess who fights on Odysseus's side during the battle with the suitors
- 22 Penelope's test of Odysseus involves his knowledge of this item that the two of them share
- 23 Odysseus uses this weapon to kill Antinous
- 24 Odysseus's loyal swineherd
- 25 Penelope's female servant who also dislikes the suitors
